Suggested Materials List.

Bring what you are most comfortable using. Rose would prefer you to bring larger surfaces to paint on so your portrait can be life size (head-size somewhere between 8-9.5 in) These canvas sizes range at least 12"x16" up through 24"x30". If you would rather work smaller it's okay too.

Rose uses:

Artefex Belgian Linen Canvas 64C (4 layers primed) or Utrecht Claessens Belgian Linen (portrait weave dp) stock #44713 or Raymar lightweight panels L64C.

We recommend that you bring between 2-3 surfaces. Larger surfaces may be best as we have more time to paint with controlled lighting.

Rose also recommends that you bring a sketch book and some sort of drawing/writing preference - ink or pencil would be her recommendation.
